

**STAINBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL**  
**Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2017**  
**At Hood Green Pavilion commencing 7.00 p.m.**

**1305. Apologies for Absence:** There were apologies for absence received from Mrs. A Riley.

**1306. To receive disclosures from Councillors on matters to be considered at the meeting:** No disclosures of personal and prejudicial interests were declared

**1307. To approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2017:** The minutes of the meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2017, having been previously circulated, were approved as a true record.

**1308. Matters arising:**

**a. Barnsley Bus Partnership Consultation:** Signs were posted on both Notice Boards highlighting details of the revised Bus services.

Details of Barnsley Bus Partnership routes received from SYPTTE as well as new map of bus routes. Paper timetables are available from the Transport Interchange. New Bus times have also be posted at each of the Bus Stops.

New routes are in operation and we have not received any reports of poor performance.

**b. Pavilion – General Improvements:** A progress report was received from the redecoration sub-committee. Further samples are to be obtained prior to colour choices being referred to the Parish Council.

A quotation has been obtained from MDB Engineering for fixed wire and portable appliance testing. The cost of £138 + VAT is to be accepted and the work should be carried out prior to the redecoration.

Brian Moss has contacted Sara of the Green and Clean Team with regard to the cutting of the hedge on the long side of the recreation ground.

**c. Safety at Stainborough Crossroads:** Brian Moss has been in touch with Richard Horsfall at Tankersley Parish Council and has been advised that ttheir use of the Speed Indicator Device is changing. Changing their batteries every two weeks has been difficult to arrange and the PC have decided to fit a solar charger kit. This allows the SID to be left in position for longer periods downloading data on a monthly basis. This experience casts doubt on our proposal to use a SID between four locations. Brian Moss advised the Parish Council that from a financial viewpoint the SID could not be funded in a single year and we would need to set aside funds over two or three years if we wish to proceed. Councillor Barnard offered to arrange for the installation of the wards SID again.

Brian to also chase Traffic re arrow/direction markers at bottom of Lowe Lane.

**d. Dog Fouling:** The last two signs are still to be fitted. Sam Lockwood Dukes to chase Totties. If they are not going to fit the sign as requested we need to have the sign back so we can find an alternative fitter.

**1309. Finance:**

**a. Grounds Maintenance Services:** BMBC have advised their charges for Grounds Maintenance Services in 2017/18. The charge for Gang mowing of the recreation ground is £608.80+VAT based on 14 visits. In addition there is a charge of £250.90+VAT for cutting of the Hood Green verges at the same frequency. The new charges represent an increase of 5% from last year. After a brief discussion the Parish Council confirmed agreement to the revised charges.
