

STAINBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL
Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 24th November 2016
At Hood Green Pavilion commencing 7.00 p.m.

- 1287. Apologies for Absence:** There were apologies for absence received from Mr. K Taylor and Mrs. A Riley
- 1288. To receive disclosures from Councillors on matters to be considered at the meeting:** No disclosures of personal and prejudicial interests were declared
- 1289. To approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 13th October 2016:** The minutes of the meeting held on 13th October 2016, having been previously circulated, were approved as a true record.
- 1290. Matters arising:**
- a. Barnsley Bus Partnership Consultation:** Brian Moss has contacted Rachel Cowling of SYPTTE who confirmed that tenders have been obtained for the new bus services and approval has been received from both Sheffield City Region and Barnsley MBC. New timetables will be operational from January 2017 but Rachel was unable to confirm the precise date.
 - b. Pavilion – General Improvements:** A quotation was requested from Dickinson Decorators for the internal painting of the Pavilion. Mark Dickinson has generously offered to carry out the work himself and not charge the Parish Council.
Brian Moss has obtained some approximate prices for laminate flooring compared to replacement of the carpet tiles. The carpet tiles are approximately £ 350 + fitting, while the cost of a suitable AC3 Heavy Domestic/Light Commercial waterproof laminate would be over £900 + fitting. At this cost level the Parish Council felt that it would be preferable to fit new carpet tiles. The Parish Council felt that it would be beneficial at this stage to form a sub-committee to cover the redecoration, new carpets and new curtains/blinds. Formation of the sub-committee will be referred to the January Meeting.
 - c. Safety at Stainborough Crossroads:** Brian Moss has contacted the Tankersley Parish Council and one of their Councillors, Richard Horsfall who deals with the practical aspects of fitting, repositioning and downloading of their SID. Richard will invite Brian Moss to view the next battery change to see the equipment first hand.
Following a number of accidents at the bottom of Lowe lane where speeding cars have been unable to negotiate the bend the installation of arrow / direction markers was suggested. Brian Moss discussed with Steve Croft and emailed Traffic.
Brian Moss discussed complaints about the on street parking on Hood Green Road with Steve Croft but was advised that this would not be supported by BMBC Highways. The formal application required would cost £4-5000 and BMBC would not cover this cost which is also beyond the budget of the Parish Council
 - d. Dog Fouling:** The last two signs are still to be fitted.
 - e. Christmas Trees:** The Christmas trees have been ordered and will be supplied during the first week in December. The Strafford Arms have generously offered to sponsor the lights for the Stainborough Tree. In order to ensure that the lights match for both trees the Parish council decided to purchase the same lights for the Hood Green Tree.
