Minutes of the Parish Council AGM held on 11th October 2018

1425. To approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 23rd August 2018: The minutes of the meeting held on 23rd August 2018, having been previously circulated, were approved as a true record.

1426. Matters arising:

a. Pavilion – General Improvements: There are several boxes in the store room which need to be checked and items no longer required disposed of to either the Hospice Shop or the Tip. Kelvin Taylor has contacted Barnsley College about the repairs to the Notice Boards and Playground Equipment. The College confirm that they will repair/replace the notice boards but work on the play equipment is still under consideration.

b. Safety at Stainborough Crossroads: Round Green Lane chevrons have been ordered but we have no indication of the timescale for installation. Brian Moss to chase Adam Davies of Roads.

c. Defibrillators: The application for the Tesco “Bags of Help” scheme is almost complete. The outstanding items will be complete in the next few days and the application will be submitted before the end of October.

d. Changes to Waste and Recycling Collections: Most of the lane to Stainborough Fold has now been tarmacked. The first section has been deliberately left with filled potholes to discourage joy riders. The Waste and Recycling collections appear to be continuing. The Parish Council have not been involved in the negotiations with BMBC, but Brian Moss will try to get more information about the agreement.
