

STAINBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL
Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 15th August 2019
At Hood Green Pavilion commencing 7.00 p.m.

1491. Apologies for Absence: There were no Apologies for Absence.

1492. To receive disclosures from Councillors on matters to be considered at the meeting: No disclosures of personal and prejudicial interests were declared

1493. To approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 11th July 2019: The minutes of the meeting held on 11th July 2019, having been previously circulated, were approved as a true record.

1494. Mrs. Sylvia Ward, National Trust: Sylvia discussed the changes made by National Trust since it reopened Wentworth Castle Gardens and the prospects for the future development. Problems with Parking were also discussed.

1495. Matters arising:

a. Pavilion – General Improvements: We have accepted the quotation from Men in Sheds for two new Notice Boards.

The timber for both benches has been obtained and is presently in Kelvin's garage awaiting treatment. Once treated Brian & Kelvin will fit the new timber slats to the existing metal supports. Kelvin approached Wickes again and obtained a great deal on the bark chippings for around the slide which he collected and installed single handed.

b. Safety at Stainborough Crossroads: The installation of the Round Green chevrons has now been completed.

Sylvia Ward of National Trust discussed the parking problems at Stainborough Crossroads caused by high traffic volumes at the newly opened Wentworth Castle Gardens. National Trust will monitor the situation but are not expecting the high visitor volumes to be repeated.

c. Defibrillators: Susan Moss organized an Afternoon Tea Event on 21st July and raised £523.72 towards the Defibrillators. Following its success, a second event was held on 11th August which raised a further £305.10 making a major contribution towards the defibrillators.

We have still not received confirmation from Tesco as to the award we will receive under their Bags for Cash Scheme.

The Strafford Arms are planning their own Raffle to raise funds for the Defibrillators and have also promised to pay for the installation and electrical work for Stainborough and Hood Green Cabinets.

d. Volunteers: Kelvin to discuss Clearing and replanting of the West Corners with Adam from Twiggs on 12 September. Subsequent projects will be scheduled for later this year and Spring 2020.
