Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 16th January 2020

1519. Apologies for Absence: No apologies were received for absence.

1522. d. Volunteers: Kelvin has discussed Clearing and replanting of the West Corners of the Recreation Ground with Adam from Twiggs. Subsequent projects will be scheduled for Spring 2020.
