

**STAINBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL**  
**Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021**  
**At Hood Green Pavilion commencing 7.00 p.m.**

**1579. Apologies for Absence:** No apologies were received for absence.

**1582. Matters arising:**

**a. Pavilion – General Improvements:** Brian has obtained prices for replacement of the swing seats and repairs to the springy dolphin at £500 inc. vat. Brian suggested that this work be deferred until the next financial year (after 5<sup>th</sup> April) Councillors felt that these repairs should proceed as soon as possible. Brian still to obtain quotations for repairs to the wall of the climbing frame.

**b. Safety at Stainborough Crossroads:** After further discussion Speed and safety at the crossroads will be monitored and raised if necessary.

**c. Defibrillators:** Training to be held in abeyance until the end of Covid19 restrictions.

**d. Volunteers:** All new proposals will be scheduled for 2021 once restrictions have been lifted.

**e. Hire of Pavilion:** Brian has been approached to hire Pavilion for single person use (rehearsal). This can be carried out within Covid guidelines and the Parish Council agreed to the short-term hire. The Pavilion will also be used for the forthcoming Local Elections on 6<sup>th</sup> May.

**1583. Finance:**

**a. Parish Precept:** We received a request from BMBC to set the level of the Parish Precept and a response was required before the Parish Council meeting. Having discussed the matter with Kelvin Taylor, Brian emailed the Councillors to confirm the proposal and having received no objections notified BMBC. An increase of 2.5% to £5073 inclusive of £156 LCTS was requested.
